From short stories written in the 1930's by the master story writer Damon Runyon, we are introduced to the world of gangsters, gamblers, and New York's other assorted sinners. In 1950 Frank Loesser took the next sensible step and made the gangsters sing and dance, and in collaboration with Jo Swerling and Abe Burrows, "Guys and Dolls" was born. The first production at the 46th Street Theatre on 24th November 1950, ran for 1200 performances and won eight Tony Awards, including "Best Musical". Enjoying its third Broadway revival in 1992 the show won another four Tony's including "Best Revival".

MGM brought this stunning musical to the big screen, starring Marlon Brando, Frank Sinatra, Stubby Kaye and Jean Simmons. Both the musical and motion picture include such memorable songs as "Sit Down, You're Rockin' the Boas", "I've Never Been in Love Before", "Fugue for Tin Horns", "Take Back Your Mink", "If I were a Bell", plus many more, and we feel sure that you will be humming some of these tunes as you leave the Theatre.
